Check Up

As we get ready for the upcoming season it is a good time to check your equipment so you can really enjoy your summer. The equipment health check-up is a simple but important routine. Through preventative action you can avoid a lot of expensive equipment and surface repairs that can arise from unmaintained equipment. Often pool owners are unsure on what is required so it is a great idea to have a pool professional conduct an inspection prior to the season commencement. The three main pieces of equipment that need a check-up are chlorinators, filters and pumps.

CHLORINATORS

- . Check the power pack to make sure there are no power issues
- . Check the timer and output to ensure the time features are correct and it is producing the correct amount of chlorine.
- . Check the cell to make sure it is clean & problem free. Even though some chlorinators are reverse polarity, the cell still requires cleaning occasionally. Saf-t-cell is the perfect product to do this as it will remove any calcium build up in and around the cell. Aquashield is also a great product to assist with keeping calcium in a softened state, ensuring chlorine production isn't inhibited.

FILTERS

- . Check you multi-port valve to make sure it moves smoothly around
- . Check your pressure gauge is working correctly
- . Check to make sure all decal labels are easy to read to save confusion
- . Ensure the media in your filter is clean and free from oils, scum & dirt build up. Take the opportunity to soak cartridges & replace media if required. A good quality filter cleaner should be used to soak cartridges.

PUMPS

Check the hair and lint pot by cleaning this out and making sure there are no splits or dirt, scum or leaves etc? Clean the fan at the back of the pump to ensure it is getting good circulation and nothing is blocking this. Also make sure the water is circulating through the pump correctly and is getting the right amount of water. Check that the pump is priming correctly.

Helpful Tips

It's easy to keep your water sparkling clear & inviting and the equipment in top operating condition. Most pool care problems can be avoided if you follow these five easy tips.
